Catalytic Converters	Referrals Available
Hazardous Liquids/Solids	Not Accepted/Referrals Available
Closed Tanks/UST	Rinsed with a 1'X 1' Opening
Sewer Covers	Ownership/Origin Documentation
Magnesium Borings	Not Accepted
Radioactive Materials	Not Accepted/Referrals Available
Transmissions	Drained, no Oil or Fluid
